You may bring your own coach if they fulfill the Copper Creek Farms requirements.

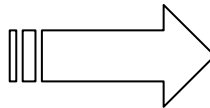
You may ride the 3 tests multiple times. Each additional test is 15 dollars. You will receive a score based on first ride.
